Master Lane is a 7th Degree Black Belt in Chuck Norris's United Fighting Arts Federation and one of his Senior Black Belts. He had trained with numerous Masters of various styles and many World Champions in various arts. He also holds high ranking Black Belts in Ju-Jitsu (I.F.O.J.J.), Judo (U.S.J.A), Tae Kwon Do, Tang Soo Do (Moo Duk Kwan) and Aikido (Nihon Goshen).



Master Lane has been inducted by his peers into the World, International Karate, International Kickboxing, National, U.S.A., Florida and Action Martial Arts Magazine Halls of Fame.



As a competitor, he has won hundreds of tournament awards including the World Lightweight PKA Kickboxing Championship in January 1975. He won nine (9) National Karate and Tae Kwon Do Championships, the 1994 Masters Sport Ju-Jitsu National Championship and the (NAKC) North America Karate Conference Championship. He retired undefeated as a world-rated professional kick-boxer. Master Lane has traveled the world over, competing, demonstrating and polishing his martial arts skills in the countries of Korea, Japan, Europe, Spain, Russia, England, Mexico, South America, Cuba and Africa, just to name a few.



Master Lane is a former U.S. Marine infantryman and an expert in small arms weapons. He was highly decorated during combat, receiving two Purple Hearts and the Bronze Star during the Vietnam War. He is also a retired police officer where he served in numerous capacities: patrol officer, S.W.A.T. team member, major crimes detective (homicide, burglary, rape, grand theft, forgeries, etc.), tactical unit leader, and training academy instructor. He is a certified International Police Defensive Tactics Instructor and is an expert in Police and Military Defensive Tactics and still does high profile body guarding assignments.
